The ninth annual Krewe of Aquarius Mardi Gras Parade, "Aquarius Awakens the Far East," will be held at noon Feb. 18, on



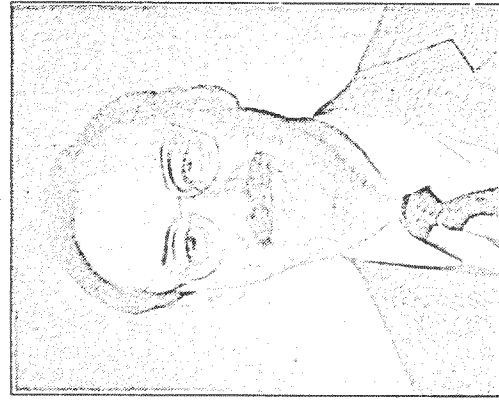

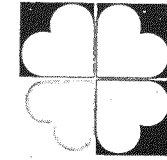
