June Meetings

The party will make three stops: Busker's on 20th and Post Office; LaFitte's on 25th for a brief floor show; then concluding a great night at JuJu's Hang Out on the Strand for drink specials, snacks, and a band.

Bylaw changes were voted on at the May 24 meeting, and one of the major modifications is the timeline for paying dues. This will have an effect on those Krewe members who have chosen to use our payment plan this year to pay dues in two installments. In order to remain a member, remaining balances must be paid by July 1. If members miss the July 1 date, they will have to re-apply for memberships and pay the \$165 amount in full. Mari Berend, membership chair, will send a reminder to those members with balances before the July 1 deadline.
