### Deacon Thomas Hunter Poster Scholarship

The Krewe of Aquarius has established a \$500 scholarship and named its annual poster contest, the Deacon Thomas Hunter Poster Scholarship, in memory of one of our founding members. All entries must be original pieces of art (no copyrighted material) and should contain no borders or writing of any kind. Each entry must represent Mardi Gras ideas along with this year's theme, "The Renaissance". Entry must be 14" wide x 20" high; entry will be vertical (portrait) not horizontal (landscape). Entry must be submitted on: (1) drawing paper, poster board, canvas or art board measuring 14x20" or (2) put into esp. format, high resolution 300+ on computer. If you submit computer disk, you must also submit a colored or black/white copy of original art measuring 14 x 20". Name, address, phone number, email and school of entrants must be submitted on the back of the art work. Entry should be submitted to Stephaine Blasé, 1207 Pilot Lane, Galveston, 77554, by November 7, 2007 or postmarked no later than November 1, 2007.
