Float #4—"The Roaring Twenties" (1998)

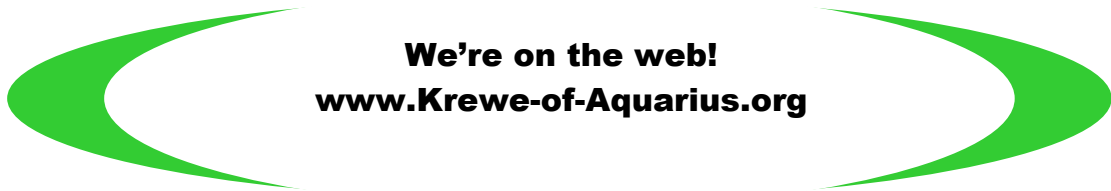
Float #6—"A Salute to New Orleans" (1996)

Additional money is allocated for float construction and decorating. The Krewe will build a new float to replace the float captained by Fran and Michelle. The new float will have a 26-rider capacity. Likewise, the "Signature Float" has outgrown its capacity and will move to the float being vacated by Fran and Michelle. The Signature Float, that always leads our parades, will feature a mezzanine, and hold 16 members plus Mr. Aquarius. Float #1, captained by Hope, will receive some much needed TLC. Plans are to leave it tri-level, but increase its length to bring it to a 26-rider capacity. The captains have a work crews for the construction, but as always, extra help is greatly appreciated.
